

What we are doing

We will be installing new underground 66,000-volt cables from the Garbutt substation, commencing from Tuesday, 2 May. Road closures and detours will be in place throughout the Garbutt substation project area until mid-June.


What to expect

During these works road users and nearby businesses can expect the following:

Localised Traffic Changes:

- The Woolcock Street Service Road behind the Ergon depot will be closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic for a period of around 6 weeks from 2nd May while 66kV cables exiting Garbutt substation are replaced.
- Traffic on the connecting road will be reduced to a single lane with portable traffic signs in place to manage traffic flow through the area see yellow shaded area in map below.
- Traffic controllers will be in place to assist and direct road users and pedestrians safely around the work site.
- Traffic will be able to exit Woolcock Street to access the Dalrymple Service Road under traffic control.
- There will be no turning onto the service road from Dalrymple Road to access Woolcock Street. To access Woolcock Street, traffic will be redirected via Hartley, Bolam and Langton Streets as per detour path on maps.
