

Windorah's new solar farm panels installed

Solar panels installed, what now

The year is going by quickly yet again and so is the installation of the solar panels at Windorah.

The project team have now installed the 320 posts, 1,280 metre of racking, 1,728 solar panels and 8 inverters to create the 880kW solar farm.

With this stage is now complete, the team is working on Stage 3 - the battery design and build. The aim is to have this completed by March - September 2025.

This work will be followed by Stage 4 – the system integration and commissioning phase, to connect the system to the electricity network. Weather permitting, this is targeted for late 2025.
